

General Terms and Conditions for the Use of the St. Moritz CC Curling Rinks in Kulm Park (GTCs)

Rental / Tournament Participation

1. The St. Moritz CC (Club) rents out its curling rinks to third parties at specified times for the purpose of playing curling. The rental includes the use of the changing rooms. So-called “sliders”, as well as stones and brooms, are provided by the Club.
2. The Club confirms each booking for the rental of curling rinks and each tournament registration by email with a written order confirmation. If the order confirmation is not contested by the renter(s) within one week of dispatch, the contract shall be deemed concluded.
3. An appropriate state of health is a prerequisite for all activities. Renters/participants undertake to inform the Club in good time of any health problems. The Club may exclude persons from its events if the physical and/or psychological requirements for a smooth and safe course of the activity are not met.

4. Payment Terms

For all activities, payment must be made by bank or postal transfer, or in cash, no later than the payment date stated on the invoice. Other payment terms will be specified in the booking confirmation. A deposit may be requested within a specified period.

Late payments entitle the Club to terminate the contract or exclude registered participants from taking part in the events. Any cancellation fees will be charged to the customer in accordance with Section 5.

5. Cancellation by Renters/Participants

Withdrawal from the contract must be made in writing or by email to the Club before the activity begins. In the event of cancellation by the renter(s), the following flat-rate charges shall be payable:

- Less than 10 days before the event: 50% of the total amount.
- Less than 2 days before the event: 100% of the total amount.

Cancellations due to official restrictions (e.g. Covid-19) are free of charge.

If the activity cannot be carried out because renters/participants arrive late or fail to appear, they shall pay 100% of the agreed price. Any additional costs arising from postponements or the late arrival of renters/participants shall be borne by them. If they join an activity only after it has begun or leave before it ends, they shall not be entitled to a refund.

6. Cancellation or Termination by the Club / Changes to the Programme

For certain events, the Club specifies minimum numbers of participants. If these numbers are not reached, the Club may cancel the event at short notice. The same applies if weather conditions do not permit use of the ice surface.

If renters/participants do not wish to rebook any of the alternative services offered to them, payments already made will be refunded, less any services already used. If an event is jeopardized or made impossible by official measures or safety risks, the Club may cancel the event or terminate it prematurely. The price paid will be refunded less any expenses already incurred by the Club. Claims for compensation are excluded.

The Club reserves the right to change the programme or parts of the agreed services if unforeseen circumstances so require. However, it will endeavour to provide an alternative service that is as equivalent as possible.

7. Liability

By registering, renters/participants acknowledge that they may be exposed to hazards that cannot be foreseen even with the best knowledge and experience. Despite the professional and safe conduct of the activities, accidents cannot be ruled out. Use of the entire facility (ice surfaces, access areas, changing rooms) is at the user's own risk. The Club accepts no liability for accidents or theft. Individual renters/participants are responsible for taking out the relevant insurance (accident insurance, including sports accidents, and theft insurance) themselves.

8. General Rules

Renters/participants are obliged to comply with the Club's conditions and to strictly follow the instructions of ice masters or Club officials.

The ice may only be entered with clean shoes. The removal of dirt or damage to the ice surface caused by negligence shall be carried out by the ice masters and charged at CHF 100 per hour.

The consumption of alcoholic beverages, food and tobacco products (cigarettes, cigars, pipes, vapes) on the ice surface is not permitted. Closed, non-breakable bottles containing drinking water or other non-alcoholic beverages are permitted.
